RUN OF SHOW

-Competitors may start to arrive as early at 4pm to setup their booth.

-Each competitor is allowed 1 person to help with their booth during the judging time.

-Each competitor will receive 2 bottles of the sponsored spirit to use to make their cocktails for the crowd.

Plan on batching at least 100 sample cocktails each. The more you batch the more chances you have of winning votes. There will be refrigeration on site if needed.

-It is the competitors task to win the votes of the crowd with their personality, station and original Molecular cocktail samples.

-During the voting process, the competitors will each have 5 minutes on stage to present their presentation cocktail where the competitors will teach the audience how they made their original Molecular cocktail and help convince the crowd to vote for them.

-Judging from the crowd will take place from 8pm-9pm.

-Each competitor will receive \$50 to help towards their cost for their ingredients.
